## BC STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Primary logo - To be used for basketball events only.

**Secondary logo** – To be used as an alternate solution where vertical spacing is limited and to represent all other spring championships.

Word marks - To be used as a supporting element in conjunction with either the BCBST logo or the primary logo.

# **GENERAL APPLICATIONS**

Full color logos take priority over one color renditions and should be used whenever reproduction capabilities allow.



Any alteration of our logos diminish their impact and is not permitted. Only approved variations should be used.

- 1. Do not stretch or skew any variation of our logo.
- 2. Do not rotate or tilt any of the approved lock-ups.
- Do not scale or change the proportions/positioning of the BlueCross Shield and Cross in any variation of our logo.
- Do not add gradients, filters, outlines, embossing, beveling, or drop shadows to any of our logos.
- 5. Do not add effects to any variation of our logo.
- 6. Do not alter the logo type in any variation of our logo.
- 7. Do not recreate the logos using unapproved colors.
- 8. Do not misuse approved colors.
- Do not place logo on bold, unsightly colors, patterns and/or imagery.
- 10.Do not reposition or change the logo or its elements.
- 11. Do not add lines or surround the logo with a stroke to any of our logos.
